



Applied Materials EMPLOYEE GIVING PROGRAM

Program Features

The Employee Giving Program offers US-based employees more choice, greater flexibility and matching gift benefit dollars.

1. Employee Matching Funds:

The Applied Materials Foundation will match an employee's personal financial contributions up to \$2000 per employee per year. Employees can “draw” upon their individual employee matching gift benefit any time during the pledge year of September 15 through August 31. To make a charitable contribution, use the online [GivingStation©](#) tool access by typing “giving” in your intranet browser.

Contributions eligible to receive matching funds include:

- Nonprofit organizations in the U.S. that have tax-exempt 501(c)(3) status from the IRS. Gifts can be pledged via payroll deduction, through the donation of fully-owned securities or via credit card).
- Kindergarten through 12th grade public and private schools in the U.S. that are nondiscriminatory. To facilitate timely distribution of funds, all gifts to schools must be made by credit card.
- More than 240 pre-selected projects that serve community needs outside the U.S. and other American-based nonprofit organizations are listed on the [GivingStation©](#).

The matching program is only available to U.S.-based full or part-time employees.

2. Donations and Matching Funds to Schools:

The Applied Materials Foundation will match employees' personal contributions to eligible Kindergarten through 12th grade public and private schools in the U.S. that are nondiscriminatory (faith-based schools must offer an opt-out policy for religious education). The school must have nonprofit (501(c)(3) or other tax-exempt status. To facilitate timely distribution of funds, all gifts to schools must be made by credit card.

To make a donation to a school, access the [GivingStation©](#). Select the "Education" focus area and locate your favorite school from the list of over 1800 pre-populated schools. If your school is not on the list, add it by using the "suggest a charity/school" link on the left navigational bar.

Employee charitable contributions to nonprofit organizations and schools will be matched up to \$2000 per year (Sept 15 - Aug 31).

Gifts and any corresponding matching funds will be paid to schools 35 days after the end of the month in which your gift was made.

3. Giving to Projects Outside the US:

Under "International Charities," employees will find featured organizations specializing in outreach to global communities in need. Employees can give to more than 240 pre-selected humanitarian projects that serve community needs outside the U.S. including projects run by Tech Museum Award Laureates, recognized for applying technology for the benefit of humanity.
